Devon & Cornwall Police are looking to recruit volunteer Police Cadet Leaders to help support the police cadet units in Liskeard, Falmouth and Camborne.



Volunteer Police Cadet Leaders help inspire young people whilst developing their own skills. They work closely with police officers and police staff to run local units, help organise group activities and whenever possible participate in initiatives to support local policing teams.

Each unit has around 20 cadets and is managed by four leaders.

Anyone over the age of 18 years old can apply for the role. There are no formal qualifications required, just commitment and enthusiasm for the police service and being part of something exciting in their local community.
