

## LANREATH PARISH COUNCIL

### Minutes of Extraordinary Parish Council Meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> August 2019

The Chair welcomed everyone to the Parish Council Meeting.

#### 1. Apologies

#### 2. Public Participation

#### 3. Planning

PA19/05577 – Erection of a covered yard and straw store. Woodsaws Farm Duloe. Messrs M J and A M Wills. Mr J Williams proposed that the application be supported. This was seconded by Miss J Tamblyn and agreed by those present. It was commented that the applicants could be encouraged to replant the trees.

#### 5. Street Light in Meadow Road

The Chair reported that a quote had been received from SSE for £4430.63 excluding VAT. Unfortunately the Parish Council does not have adequate funds to go ahead with this. The Chair has contacted Cornwall Council who have commented that if the Parish Council installs the street light, then they would be prepared to adopt it. Mr J Williams proposed that the Parish Council does not proceed with this at the current time but should be borne in mind should any additional funding become available. This was seconded by Mrs E Lee and agreed by those present.

#### 6. Telephone box in Herodsfoot

It was reported that correspondence has been received from BT regarding the possible removal of the box and telephone. Following a poll carried out in Herodsfoot among the residents, who wish to retain the box and phone due to the very poor phone signal in the village, it was agreed that the clerk reply to BT accordingly.

#### 7. Any Other Business

**Stile by the vicarage** – it was reported that the step down is too high.

**Community Garden** – the bamboo has been dug out and the ground backfilled with soil. To be placed on the September agenda regarding seeking funding from the Fursdown fund.

**Drains at Bury Down** – the Chair reported that a reply has been received from the Land Registry regarding the lane stating that the definitive plans show a common boundary. There would therefore be the need to look at the deeds of the respective landowners on either side of the lane. It was queried whether to go back to BT stating this fact and advising that the lane was improved BT and therefore it should be for BT to clear the drains. Miss J Tamblyn added that the drains on the main road appear to be in the incorrect position. Clerk to contact Mr Paul Allen at Highways to request a site visit.
