Members of the public are welcome at Parish Council meetings, and can speak, if they wish, during Public Participation. If you are unable to attend but wish to comment on the agenda, email the Clerk in advance and your comments will be included in the appropriate part of the discussion.

HOW DO I KNOW WHAT IS GOING TO BE DISCUSSED?

We publish the agenda of our public meetings on our website at least three working days beforehand so you can see what we are discussing. You can read any documents that will be discussed at the meeting by visiting the website. Residents are always welcome to attend public meetings as observers or to take part. There is no need to give notice, but if you are attending and want to comment on any of the items on the agenda or raise an issue with the councillors, time is set aside at the beginning and end of every meeting for you to speak.

HOW DO I KNOW WHAT HAS HAPPENED DURING A MEETING?

We publish draft minutes of all our public meetings within two weeks of the meeting itself.
